Bounce Houses / Inflatables

Operator/Attendant Responsibility Checklist

- ___ **NO:** Shoes, eyeglasses, jewelry, or other sharp objects
- ___ **NO:** Somersaults, diving, wrestling, rough play or flips.
- ___ **NO:** Food, drinks, gum, pets or silly string.
- ___ Bounce House must always have **adult supervision** when in use.
- ___ The Bounce House must be securely anchored at all times.
- ___ Entry into the Bounce House should be orderly and in a controlled manner.
- ___ Riders should be of similar age range, height, and weight.
- ___ **Do not put older children or adults with young children.**
- ___ Individuals who may be particularly susceptible to injury from falls bumps or bouncing should not use this product. You should consult a physician before using this product.
- ___ Do not jump onto or off of the ride.
- ___ Use of whistles and signaling devices is recommended.
- ___ Keep patrons away from the blower at all times.
- ___ **DO NOT USE** and immediately deflate the inflatable if wind conditions exceed 15 mph and/or if it rains.

FOR RIDES WITH CLIMBS OR SLIDES

- ___ Go down feet first only.
- ___ **NO:** Climbing up the wrong way.
- ___ **NO:** Jumping onto the slide area.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the unlikely event of a severe weather alert, power failure or medical emergency:

- ___ Exit patrons in an orderly fashion away from the game.
- ___ Turn off the blower and unplug from the outlet.
- ___ Keep patrons and guests away from the inflatable.
- ___ Call the appropriate emergency responders if necessary.
